The main hall is a hie-zukuri style constructed building with a cypress bark roof. The hiyoshizukuri is a special style of architecture found only within the grounds of Hiyoshi Taisha Shrine, and is characterized by the usage of roof eaves on the front and sides of a building. The current main hall was constructed in 1586, and renovated in 1597. It was designated a National Treasure in 1961.
