Hiyoshi Taisha Shrine - Two-Story Gate of the Eastern Main Shrine

Important Cultural Property

[Around A.D.1573-1593]

The Two-Story Gate possesses a gabled, hipped roof made with cypress bark. A Japanese two-story gate (“Roumon”) is a gate with a roof only on the second floor and a rim above the first floor. The Two-Story Gate was constructed around 1573-1593, and was designated an Important Cultural Property in 1923.
