The Usajingu's Main Hall is a hie-zukuri style constructed building with a cypress bark roof. The hiyoshi-zukuri is a special style of architecture found only within the grounds of Hiyoshi Taisha Shrine, and is characterized by the usage of roof eaves on the front and sides of a building. The Main Hall is famous for its high flooring with large exposed rocks. The hall was constructed in 1598, and was designated as an Important Cultural Property in 1901.
