The Main Hall of Ushio Shrine is a large scale nagare-zukuri style constructed building with a cypress bark roof, and its Worship Hall possesses a gabled, hipped roof made with cypress bark. The Worship Hall is shaped to incorporate the Main Hall behind it, and is distinct in that it is built over a cliff. The current buildings were constructed in 1595, and received the designation of Important Cultural Property in 1907.
