Toshogu Shrine was built utilizing the distinctive architectural style of construction known as gongen-zukuri. The gongen-zukuri style is characterized by having a Main Hall and Worship Hall that are connected by a corridor, creating a shape similar to the letter “H.” The shrine is distinct for its luxurious interior and exterior decorations. Today ’ s Toshugu Shrine was constructed in 1634, and was designated an Important Cultural Property in 1917.
