Toshogu Shrine was built utilizing the distinctive architectural style of construction known as gongen-zukuri. The gongen-zukuri style is characterized by having a Main Hall and Worship Hall that are connected by a corridor, creating a shape similar to the letter "H." The shrine is distinct for its luxurious interior and exterior decorations. Today 's Toshugu Shrine was constructed in 1634, and was designated an Important Cultural Property in 1917.
