Saikyoji Temple Bell Tower

Designated Tangible Cultural Property of Otsu City

[1831]

Saikyoji Temple's Bell Tower is a building with a hip-and-gable roof that uses ceramic tiles. The tower is constructed entirely of wood from zelkova trees, features elaborately detailed support beams, and a lower skirt shaped trapezoid pedestal which stands on a hewn stone base. The bell tower was built in 1831, according to a building tag and inscriptions on railing toppers on the railed veranda.
