I7\_I\_English\_桐畑古墳群 Kirihata Burial Mounds (Kumagaya Burial Mounds)

The Kirihata Burial Mounds consist of six circular mounds dating back around 1,400 years, and are located on the eastern slope of the same hill as the Hyakketsu Burial Mounds. Three of the been discovered to possess mounds have horizontal stone chambers with dome shaped walls, which may have been influenced by China or the Korean peninsula. The largest mound of cluster is the 1st mound, which is the approximately 20 meters in diameter and has an opening to its stone chamber on its eastern side. Currently, the Buddhist deity Acala (Fudo-son) is enshrined in the stone chamber and is an object of worship.
