Nagara Shrine – Two Story Gate

Designated a Cultural Property of Otsu City

[A.D.1905]

Nagara Shrine's two-story gate possesses a gabled, hipped roof made with cypress bark. Its architecture is based on the style of the Muromachi period [1336-1573], and is considered to be a perfect example of a Meiji period [1868-1912] two-story gate. Diagrams, blueprints, and other materials related to the construction of the gate are preserved in good condition to this day. It was designated a Cultural Property of Otsu City in 1972.
