Garden of Rokasensuisou

Designated Place of Scenic Beauty of Otsu City

Early Showa Era [1926–1989]

The Rokasensuisou is a vacation home for the famous artist Shunkyo Yamamoto, who was known for their works from the Meiji Period [1868–1912] to the early Showa Period [1926–1989]. The Garden of Rokasensuisou was originally constructed bordering Lake Biwa, and the gardening was kept low to the ground with Lake Biwa and Mt. Mikami (also known as “Omi Fuji”) used as a background for the landscaping. This garden is also a great example of a Shiga Prefecture garden from the early Showa period.
