Kokubu Otsuka Burial Mound

Designated Historic Site of Otsu City

According to excavations conducted in the area, the Kokubu Otsuka Burial Mound was determined to be a 45-meter-long keyhole-shaped burial mound with a surrounding moat around it. The front and rear sections of the mound each possess one tomb with a horizontal stone chamber, and the mound is the furthest south keyhole-shaped burial mound located in Otsu. The mound is thought to have been constructed during the Kofun period (500–600).
