The wooden god statue is made from a single, unpainted piece of wood, and was carved using simple techniques. The statue's most notable features are its large crown the protruding scepter that is held in both hands. The goddess statue is also made from one piece of wood, and aside from features such as the hair, eyebrows, and eyes which are drawn in with ink, is unpainted. The style of this statue is the same as the god statue, and is thought to be a set sculpted by the same artist made during the 10th-12th century.
