The construction of Takamura Shrine's main hall is a rarity in Japan due to its gabled roof and "Hirairi" layout, which is a Japanese traditional architectural structure where the building has its main entrance on the side which runs parallel to the roof's ridge. From the style of its construction, it is estimated that the main hall was constructed around 1340. The hall's enshrined deity is Ono no Takamura [802–852], who was a politician, as well as a poet of both Chinese and Japanese styles. It was designated an Important Cultural Property in 1907.
