Mt. Mandara Burial Mounds

The Mt. Mandara Burial Mounds is a large cluster of 116 mounds, consisting primarily of round burial mounds with horizontal stone chambers. Thought to have been constructed between 550-600, these mounds span across Mt. Mandara and its neighboring western hill. A relationship between these mounds and the ancient Wani clan has also been observed. While some of its stone material has been removed, the 34th mound possesses a horizontal stone chamber with an entrance opening on its west side.
