The Mt. Mandara Burial Mounds is a large cluster of 116 mounds, consisting primarily of round burial mounds with horizontal stone chambers. Thought to have been have constructed between 550–600, these mounds span across Mt. Mandara and its neighboring western hill. A relationship between these mounds and the ancient Wani clan has also been observed. While some of its stone material has been removed, the 34th mound possesses a horizontal stone chamber with an entrance opening on its west side.
