Zeniwara Burial Mound

The Zeniwarara Burial Mound is located at the foot of the 149-meter-high Mt. Mandara in the Ono Asahi 2-chome region of Otsu. Mt. Mandara is home to the Mt. Mandara Burial Mounds, which consists of 117 mounds in total. Among those 117 mounds, the Zeniwarara Burial Mound's stone burial chamber is one of the largest in size in the area. The burial mound is believed to have been constructed in 575 based on Sue ware that was unearthed from the mound. It is also presumed that a member of one of the powerful families in the Wani and Ono regions of Otsu who were active during the mid-6th century is buried here.
