foundational platform This measures approximately 18 meters from east to west, and 15 meters from north to south, and is presumed to have been the base for a long horizontal main hall building with the south side being the front entrance. The platform has a simple exterior, and was constructed using a technique known as "Hanchiku," which involves gradually piling up and beating on dirt to create a solid structure. Remains of a base stone on the platform, as well as the positioning of a foundational stone, have discovered. However, the original been foundational stone has never been found, and the current one is a replica.
