In 1336, Yoshisada Nitta [?~1338] was on his way to Echizen Province (modern day Fukui Prefecture) after being defeated by Takauji Ashikaga [1305–1358]'s army, and left his wife, Koutou Naishi, in Imakatata. After learning her husband Yoshisada had been killed in battle in 1338, it is said that Koutou Naishi was so griefstricken that she threw herself into the nearby lake. The locals pitied Koutou Naishi, and built a mound in her honor that eventually became Nogami Shrine in 1497. A ceremony is still held to this day on the anniversary of her death.
