Kinugawa Temple Ruins (Construction Process)

National Historic Site

The Kinugawa Temple Ruins are located on the edge of a small hill. During the construction of the foundation for the main hall, a tile kiln was also built and used to produce roof tiles. The temple's tower entered the construction phase, but was ultimately never completed. The temple had been abandoned by the end of the Heian period, and was eventually used as a cemetery for Ryuzuiji Temple during the Edo period.
